- Out-of-school experiences, including summer activities, work, and hobbies that reflect responsibility, dedication, and areas of interest
  - Meaningful use of your free time is essential!
  - Students should include these commitments on their résumés.
- 6. Special talents or experiences that will contribute to an interesting, well-rounded student body
  - A student who goes the extra mile to develop a special talent will gain an edge.
  - Students should consider sending a college evidence of anything that makes them stand out
- 7. A well-written essay that provides insight into the student's personality, values, and goals
  - An application essay should be thoughtful and highly personal.

# Top 10 things colleges are looking for in applicants

- 8. Letters of recommendation that give evidence of his or her intellectual curiosity, special skills, and positive character traits.
- 9. Demonstrated enthusiasm for attending a university
- 10. Demonstrated intellectual curiosity through reading, school, and extracurricular pursuits, summer activities, and more
