Day 1/2: (Siena) Take off for the adventure of a lifetime surrounded by the beauty of the Tuscan landscape. You arrive in the city of Rome where a motor coach waits to take you to the city of Siena. Day 4: (San Gimignano): The morning begins with a stroll through the Sienese market. The market provides a great way for visitors to get a tiny insight into daily life of the Sienese. After the market, you will be transferred to San Gimignano. You will start with lunch at a local enoteca where great food and even better wine awaits. Your guide will take you on a walking tour of the town to see the many unique sites including the Duomo di San Gimignano. Along the way, sample the vernancia, golden wine and cinhiale, wild boar. You tour will end at the Dondoli's world famous gelato shop. Here the owner will give you an overview of gelato making and of course, there will be plenty of samples.

Day 5: (Monteriggioni) Today we head north to a farm just outside of Siena where local farmers have prepared for you to sample their celebrated homemade wines and foods. This experience will truly connect you to nature and the Tuscan countryside. After you have dined, you will be transferred to Monteriggioni. This is a classic example of a medieval hilltop town with its iconic encompassing wall. It is easily walked and has many charming stores and shops to discover. The evening is left free for you to explore as you wish. Your guide will have many recommendations for cafes, music revenues, etc...

Assisi's main attraction is the Basilica di San Francesco, which contains the sacred relics of Francis and beautiful frescoes of his life. The town of Assisi, with its Roman ruins, winding medieval streets and sacred shrines, has been a major Catholic pilgrimage destination for centuries and is today one of the most popular tourist destinations in Italy.
